

Pre Ballet: STREET CLOTHES SHOULD BE WORN TO AND FROM THE STUDIO. Hair must be pulled off the face. Leotard (of any color) and tights are required. Ballet shoes must be worn (pink is suggested, as it will be required for performances). Skirts, tutus, dance dresses, etc. are allowed. ATTIRE MUST BE MODEST!

Ballet I-Ballet V: STREET CLOTHES SHOULD BE WORN TO AND FROM THE STUDIO. Girls: Hair pulled tightly into a ballet bun. Leotard (of any solid color) and tights are required. Ballet shoes must be worn (pink is suggested, as it will be required for performances). Ballet skirts and/or shorts may be worn, however, the instructor may ask for them to be removed if they inhibit the dancers' lines etc from being seen. Boys: Black or white shorts, dance belt, white T-shirt, white socks and black or white ballet slippers. Adult Men & Women: Choice of dance apparel. ATTIRE MUST BE MODEST!

Jazz: STREET CLOTHES SHOULD BE WORN TO AND FROM THE STUDIO. "Dance- able" clothes must be worn. Jeans are not allowed. Dancer can be barefoot, or wear modern or jazz shoes. No street shoes. No bare mid-drifts. ATTIRE MUST BE MODEST!

Tap: Tap shoes are required. Jeans are not allowed. ATTIRE MUST BE MODEST!

Hip Hop: Baggy clothing and sneakers **must** be worn. ATTIRE MUST BE MODEST!
